Irish international show jumper Darragh Kenny and his team at Oakland Stables are thrilled to announce their partnership with Ox Ridge Riding & Racquet Club, based in Darien, Connecticut. Darragh began competing in the sport of show jumping at the age of 10 in his homeland of Offaly, Ireland. He quickly moved up the ranks, competing in his first grand prix at the age of 14. Darragh eventually made the decision to move to the United States where he quickly made a name for himself. Darragh has amassed countless career highlights over the years, including being nominated by the Olympic committee to represent Team Ireland at the Tokyo Olympics. He currently sits within the top-16 on the Longines FEI World Rankings.

Additionally upon coming to America, he formed Oakland Stables. Since its inception, Oakland has become one of the most successful competition barns in the industry, offering high-performance sales horses and an elite training program. The training program at Oakland Stables has helped students reach goals in the sport they didn't know possible. After training with the Oakland team for over seven years and beginning in the Low Junior Jumpers, student Teddy Vlock reached his lifetime goal of competing at the Olympic level during the Tokyo Olympics in the summer of 2021. Additionally, Darragh and his training team at Oakland have help other students such as Mimi Gochman and Kerry McCahill move up the ranks to compete successfully at the CSI4* and 5* level across the globe.

In addition to Darragh's expertise, Stephen Moore will head training at the newly appointed Oakland Stables at Ox Ridge Riding and Racquet Club. Stephen, who has worked alongside Darragh for many years, is a life-long equestrian from Galway, Ireland. Stephen has earned a number of international successes in the jumper ring, while simultaneously training his students to work up the ranks to the highest levels of the sport, including Teddy Vlock's climb to the





Olympic level. Stephen will join the already experienced team at Ox Ridge, including trainers Maggie Boylan who has been involved with Ox Ridge for many years.
