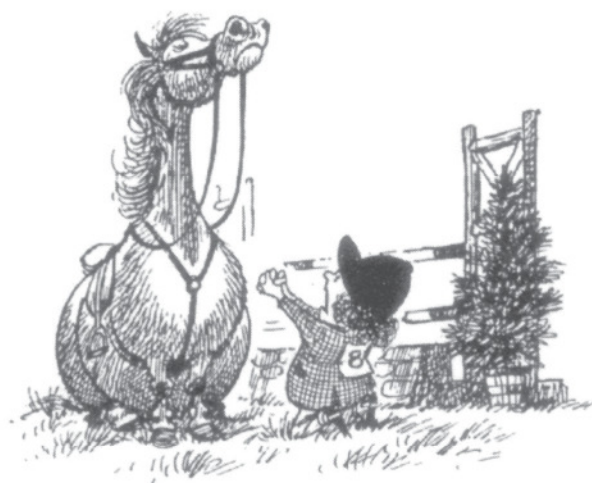
## THE HORSE SHOW SPECTATOR'S GUIDE

Welcome to the wonderful world of horses and horse showing. Horse shows are fun and exciting for the spectator, but they may also be confusing. The uninitiated may wonder: what's going on? How do all these horses and riders know what to do? Is what's going on in one ring different from what's going on in another ring? How does the judge pick the winner? Read on and you will have a better understanding of this magnificent sport - the horses, the Riders the Judges and the shows. The Ox Ridge Hunt Club Horse Show is an "AA" show, the highest rated show offered under American Horse Show Association (AHSA) rules. The show's Grand Prix is also recognized by the United States Equestrian Team (USET).

There are also non-recognized shows, which are usually informal in atmosphere and give experience to beginner and novice horses, ponies and riders.

For every show, the judge for each ring is responsible for selecting the top six to twelve places, depending on the class. The winners are announced at the conclusion of each class. For some classes, such as the Hunter Classics, two judges will judge the class and assign a numerical score for each horse shown. The score is announced after each horse completes the course with the final standings being announced at the conclusion of the class.

Points are awarded for placings at AHSA recognized shows. The higher the show's rating, the greater the number of points that are earned for each placing. These points are accumulated during the course of the show season and go toward Zone (Regional) and National Awards, and, in the case of the USET, are used to determine placement on the United States Equestrian Team.



AHSA Steward insures that the show is run in compliance with AHSA rules and acts as a liaison between judges, management, and exhibitors should the need arise. At a large show, such as the Ox Ridge Hunt Club Horse Show, more than one Steward officiates. Each horse show also has a show secretary. The show secretary is responsible for taking entries, collecting entry fees, verifying membership in the AHSA and other organizations as required by class specifications, issuing numbers and providing the announcer and starter with a list of all competitors entered in each class. At the conclusion of the show the secretary reports the results to the AHSA so that the appropriate points may be awarded to qualifying horses and riders.

A "starter" or "paddock master" is assigned to each ring. These key people are responsible for keeping the classes on schedule by getting the riders into the ring in a continuous flow. For jumping classes, the courses are posted at the in-gate of the appropriate ring. Most AHSA recognized shows, including the Fairfield County June Benefit Horse Show, offers classes that can be divided into three basic divisions: Equitation, Hunters, and Jumpers.

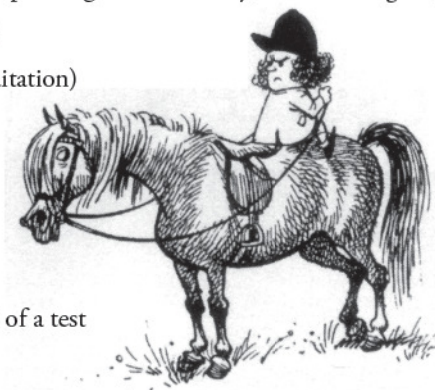

# JUDGING THE SHOW

When judging the rider (equitation) or the horse (hunter), the rider and horse should appear relaxed, and the riding should appear effortless. According to the judges opinion and depending on the severity, the following may be considered major or minor faults:

- incorrect lead or change when cantering
- incorrect diagonal when trotting (for equitation)
- knocking down any part of a jump
- kicking out, bucking
- circling while on course
- exceeding the time limit
- trotting on course unless required as part of a test



## For jumpers:

- Poor presentation of the rider or horse or pony
- Riders are eliminated for the following:
- Three refusals (stopping in front of a fence)
- Fall of horse or rider or pony
- Going off course, which is jumping the jumps in the wrong order

# JUMPERS



Jumper classes are favorites for spectators as they are exciting and easy to follow and judge! Jumper classes are judged on "faults" and "time". The standard is cut and dry; you either have the fastest clean round or you don't ("clean" meaning no faults). Each class is judged on the rules defined in the program. A fault is a numerical penalty for an error. A rail or any part of the jump that establishes

the height of the jump that is knocked down is called a jump-fault. Lowering the height of the fence counts as four faults. A refusal is four faults for the first refusal, and eight faults for the second refusal. The third refusal results in elimination. There is also a "time limit" and a "time allowed" for each course.

The time limit is the time in which you must finish the course or be eliminated, The time allowed is the time you have to complete the course without accumulating time faults, A time fault is given for each second or fraction of a second over the time allowed. A clean round is one where there are no time or jumping faults. If more than one horse has gone clean, a timed "jump-off" breaks the tie. Should two or more horses have an equal number of jumping faults, the one with the fastest time is the winner, with second place going to the second fastest time etc.

The Jumper Division is also divided by the status of the rider, age of the rider and, additionally, by the amount of money the horse has won.

"Open" classes are open to anyone wishing to ride in the division. Junior jumpers and Children's jumpers must be ridden by a junior (under 18 years old). In the Amateur division, the horse must be ridden by an amateur.

The Preliminary Jumper division is open to horses having won less than \$5,000 in a certain time period and the Intermediate Jumper division is open to horses having won less than \$10,000 in a certain time period. The jumps range in size from 3'6" for amateurs and juniors up to 5'6" for the Grand Prix.

The Jumper Division is the only division that is offered at the international and Olympic levels.

# EQUITATION

Equitation classes judge the rider on the guidance of the horse, position of legs, hands and upper body, and the ability to perform certain "tests" with style and precision. The rider's legs should be perpendicular to the ground and "quiet" with the heel down. Hands should be supple and follow the horses' mouth. The upper body should be erect but relaxed with an arch in the lower back, head up and looking forward. Equitation classes are generally

judged "on the flat" (walk, trot, and canter in both directions of the ring) and "over fences" (Jumping). classes may be for adults (over 18 years of age) and children. The height of the fence (jump) also varies from 18" for Short Stirrup to 3'9" inches for upper level classes. Upper level equitation classes include the ASPCA Maclay, the AHSA Hunt Seat Medal and the USET. Riders accumulate wins and points to qualify for the year-end finals.



# HUNTERS

The Hunter Division judges the horse. A hunter should have a long, low, ground covering stride and jump the fences easily and smoothly. The hunter should be quiet and mannerly both over fences and under saddle", which consists of walk, trot, canter, and sometimes a hand gallop, in both directions of the ring. At the conclusion of jumping classes, hunters are often "jogged for soundness" (trotted in a line in front of the judge led on foot by the rider) before the placings are made final. Any horse or pony not deemed to be serviceably sound (lame) will be eliminated.

The Hunter classes may be divided based on the age of the rider, status of the rider, and size or experience of the horse or pony. The Short Stirrup Hunter must be ridden by a child 12 years old and under, while the Amateur Owner division may be divided 18-35 years old and over 35 years old. The height of the fences vary according to the section, from 2' to 4'6".

Pony Hunters are divided into three sections: small ponies may not exceed 12.2 hands; medium ponies are over 12.2 hands but not to exceed 13.2 hands; and large ponies are over 13.2 hands but not to exceed 14.2 hands. (A hand is 4"). Hunter horses may also be divided by height if the class is large. Hunter divisions may also be divided by the show experience of the horse and the rider.



Hunters are judged on manners.

## SHOW JUMPING SPECTATOR BASICS

The horse and rider compete over a set course of jumps. The goal is to complete the course with the least number of faults within the allotted time.

**Faults:** 1st refusal: 4 faults; 2nd refusal: 8 faults, 3rd refusal: Elimination

Knockdown of an obstacle, standard or wing: 4 faults

Fall of horse or rider: Elimination

Exceeding the time allowed to complete the course: A fault for each second over the time allowed.

**The Fences (Jumps):** The degree of difficulty of a jump is determined by its height, width, construction, and its placement in relation to the other jumps on the course.

**Rail:** The wooden bars used on jumps. They must be a minimum of six feet in length and four inches in diameter. Rails usually measure 14 feet in length.

**Vertical:** A straight up and down fence of any height without spread or width. Although it looks relatively simple, it is actually one of the most difficult fences for a horse to jump and tests the horse's ability to jump height.

**Gate:** A vertical made to appear solid by using planks.

**Wall:** As it is named, a solid fence with the top several sections made of individual blocks which can be dislodged for a knockdown penalty.

**Oxer:** This jumps consists of two vertical jumps placed several feet apart, and can be as wide as five to six feet. Types of oxers include square, in which the front and back rails are of equal height and is the most difficult to jump, ascending, in which the front rail is lower than the back rail, and descending, in which the front rail is higher than the back rail.

**Triple Bar:** Another type of spread fence using three elements of graduating heights.

**Combination:** This is a series of fences one or two strides apart. The horse must jump each fence successively with only time for one or two strides between fences. The fences in a combination are marked with the same number followed by the letter of order, i.e., 1 A, 1 B, 1 C. If a horse stops or refuses a fence at any part of the combination, the rider must start over again from the first fence and jump the entire combination.

**Water Jump:** The fence consists of a low hedge and a pool of water between 12' and 16'. The horse must clear the white tape on the far side of the water or incur jumping faults. (Continued on next page)







## SHOW JUMPING SPECTATOR BASICS

*(Continued from previous page)*

**Stride:** The amount of ground a horse covers. At the canter, the average stride of a horse is 12 feet. The distances on jumping courses are set accordingly.

**Schooling:** Practice or training before the competition. The riders practice in a schooling area. They are not allowed to practice on the actual course.

**Starting Order:** The order in which the competitors compete. Determined in a drawing before the event so that each rider has an equal chance of getting a favorable position. Riders near the end of the starting order have the advantage of seeing how the first riders complete the course.

**Course:** Fences are positioned with the distance between them carefully measured to calculate the maximum time allowed the riders have to complete the course without incurring time penalties. This time is based on a speed of 360 yards per minute for courses under 700 yards, and 382 yards per minute for courses over 700 yards.

**Walking the Course:** Riders walk the course to measure the number of strides their horses will need between jumps. Each rider knows the length of his horse's stride. [Roughly 12 to 14 human paces equals one canter stride of a horse.] The riders pace off the distance between fences to determine how best to guide their horses to each fence.

**Clean Round:** When the horse and rider complete all jumps on the course without a single fault or penalty.

**The Jump Off:** The riders who have a clean round compete in a timed jump-off over the shortened course to determine the winner. The jump-off is scored in the same manner as the first round. The winner is the horse and rider with the fewest faults in the fastest time.

**Ribbons:** Ribbons are awarded to the winners as follows:  
 1st - Blue; 2nd - Red; 3rd - Yellow; 4th - White; 5th - Pink;  
 6th - Green; 7th - Purple; 8th - Brown; 9th - Gray;  
 10th - Light Blue.

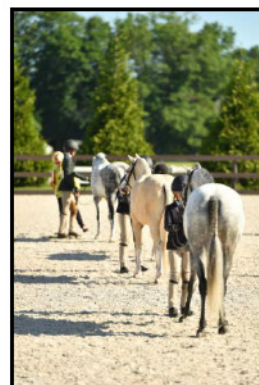

Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding**
3. Hunter fences to include brush, gate, wall, in and out, aiken, natural rails. Jumper fences to include brush, coop, wall, planks, panels, liverpools, natural obstacles and rails.
4. Ox Ridge Hunt Club and Horse Show Management shall not be liable whatsoever for any injury or damage to any person or property of any spectator, visitor, attendant or any other persons, or animals by reason of any event occurring during the show, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor hold the same as well as their agents and/ or employees harmless for any accident or loss which may occur by fire or otherwise.
5. The right is reserved to cancel, combine or divide any classes if entries warrant. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation.
6. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each class. Management reserves the right to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a **MANDATORY LINE**. The same will be indicated on course diagrams and a corresponding barrier will be erected in the ring.

10. Absolutely **NO DOGS** or other pets allowed on the grounds unless leashed and under control. \$50 Fine for unleashed dogs.
11. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.
12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have **CURRENT MEMBERSHIPS** for any and all classes, which require the same.
13. **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted if time permits at \$50.00 per horse; Late entries may be accepted at Managers discretion.
14. **PRIZE MONEY** will be applied to the exhibitor's outstanding account if any, or mailed to the exhibitor as listed on the entry blank within 30 days of the close of the show. Checks void after 60 days. The horse show will not stop payment or duplicate awards for any lost check. Federal ID or Social Security Number is required.



15. **STALLS: LIMITED STABLING AVAILABLE.** Stabling will be on a first come, first served basis. Temporary stabling of canvas construction with doors available at \$285.00 per stall. No initial bedding provided. ***No wiring of any kind allowed in the stabling areas.*** Closing date to reserve stalls is May 10, 2019. No refunds on stalls after the closing date. Stalls will not be available until 11 am Monday. **Ship in Charge \$125.00 per Horse.**
16. **REFUNDS:** In case of any horse being entered and not shown and not scratched, the entry fees will be forfeited. An office processing fee of \$60.00 per legitimately scratched animal will be deducted from the refund.
17. **ENTRIES CLOSE MAY 10, 2019.** All stall fees must be paid May 10, 2019. Stalls will not be held after this date if not paid in full. Mail entries to Ox Ridge Hunt Club, PO Box 1067, 512 Middlesex Road, Darien CT 06820. For FedEx, 512 Middlesex Road, Darien CT 06820. Please enclose an open signed check for entries. ***A Post Entry Fee of \$50.00 per horse will be charged to entries received after the closing date.***
18. The right is reserved to limit the number of entries accepted in any and all divisions. If entries must be limited, they will be selected on a first come, first served basis, selected by the postmark date.
19. **ADDS & SCRATCHES:** Entries must add & scratch prior to the beginning of the class with the show office. Horses shown in a class without being entered will pay a charge of \$55.00 in addition to the class entry fee. Horses that are not scratched prior to the start of the class will not have entry fees refunded.
20. There will be a \$50.00 fee for any returned check.
21. Every class offered herein which is recognized by CHJA will be conducted and judged in accordance with the current CHJA Rules. To show in CHJA Medal classes, riders **MUST** be members. In order to compete for CHJA annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHJA. A copy of the CHJA Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications and membership Applications are available at the show office and at [www.chja.net](http://www.chja.net).
22. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of the rule will be cause for sanctions against the parents, guardians, and/or trainers who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent, guardian, and/or trainer from the Competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

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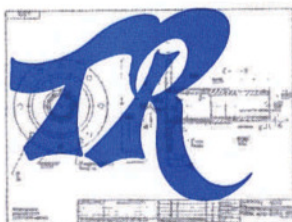
